The Government of Sindh has received financing from the World Bank toward the cost of the Sindh Flood Emergency Housing Reconstruction Project and intends to apply part of the proceeds toward payments under the contract for Management Information System (MIS) for WASH (Water, Sanitation & Hygiene) and Village/Settlement Improvement.
2. The Sindh People's Housing for Flood Affectees now invites sealed Proposals from eligible Proposers to support SPHF WASH and settlement improvement initiatives through designing, developing, and implementing a comprehensive, and user-friendly Management Information System (MIS) for managing related activities. The MIS should provide a platform for real-time data entry, development of system-based Project Design Digests (PDDs), reporting, financial management, analysis, and decision support to enhance the effectiveness of the project, improve transparency, and optimize resource allocation.
3. The procurement process will be conducted through national competitive procurement using Request for Proposals (RFP) as specified in the World Bank's "Procurement Regulations for IPF Borrowers" Procurement in Investment Project Financing, Goods, Works, Non-Consulting and Consulting Services – Fourth Edition, November 2020 ("Procurement Regulations"), and is open to all eligible Proposers as defined in the Procurement Regulations.
4. Bids will be evaluated in accordance with the evaluation process set out in the bidding documents. The following weightings shall apply for Rated Criteria (including technical and non-price factors): 70% and for Bid cost: 30%.

5. Interested eligible Proposers may obtain further information from Sindh People's Housing for Flood Affectees (SPHF) through email at cpo@sphf.gos.pk and inspect the request for proposals document during office hours.
6. The request for proposals document in English may be purchased by interested eligible Proposers upon the submission of a written application to the address below and upon payment of a nonrefundable fee of PKR 15,000 through Pay Order in favor of Sindh People's Housing for Flood Affectees.
7. Proposals must be delivered to the address below on or before **08th July 2025 at 03:00 pm**. Electronic procurement **will not** be permitted. Late Proposals will be rejected. The outer Proposal envelopes marked "ORIGINAL PROPOSAL", and the inner envelopes marked "TECHNICAL PART" will be publicly opened in the presence of the Proposers' designated representatives and anyone who chooses to attend, at the address below on **08th July 2025 at 03:00 pm**. All envelopes marked "FINANCIAL PART" shall remain unopened and will be held in safe custody of the Purchaser until the second public Proposals opening.
8. All Proposals must be accompanied by a Proposal Security of 2% of the total bid amount.
9. Attention is drawn to the Procurement Regulations requiring the Borrower to disclose information on the successful Proposer's beneficial ownership, as part of the Contract Award Notice, using the Beneficial Ownership Disclosure Form as included in the request for proposal document.
